

THE AUSTRALIAN MERCHANT NAVY AWARDS COUNCIL

The following guidance and form is provided to applicant's seeking the award of an Australian Merchant Navy Service Cross for 15 years sea service on Australian merchant ships¹. An application must be accompanied by supporting evidence accepted by the Australian Merchant Navy Awards Council (AMNAC) which would normally take the form of discharges, letters of service by Company(s) or equivalent. Once the application form and supporting documentation is complete it should be submitted to the AMNAC's Registrar at:

Once the application has been assessed you will be advised (please include your email address in you application) whether you need to provide more information or that you can contact the AMNAC's Special Agent to arrange for payment and the issue of your Service Cross. Note the AMNAC's Special Agent, Tasmanian Numismatic Consultancy is authorised to charge A\$120.00 to cover the costs associated with production, distribution and administration associated with this award.
